

THINGS TO DO

Corte Madera Ecological Reserve

S.F. Bay Frontage - East of Hwy 101 between Corte Madera Creek & Village Center This fabulous open space and wildlife preserve is a 204-acre Ecological Reserve where hikers and bikers enjoy the spacious vistas and wildflowers. Birdwatchers also flock here to view feeding and nesting areas for migrating meadowlarks, great egrets, snowy egrets, avocets and sandpipers.

Ring Mountain Open Space Preserve

Ring Mountain Open Space Preserve, nestled between the Marin County towns of Tiburon and Corte Madera, possesses an amazing variety of assets. The grassy slopes afford fantastic views of Mount Tamalpais, the bay, and San Francisco. Hiking trails wind through rock formations, across tiny creeks, through wildflower dotted hillsides, and under old coast live oaks and California bays. Petroglyph Rock, near the preserve's highest spot, has rock carvings created by Native Americans.

The stretches of trail that run next to the creek are smooth and wide and most suitable for beginners. Skating through marshland along the creek is idyllic, and with the sun setting over Mount Tam, it is - indescribable.

These trails are a system of not-quite-interconnecting paths in the Twin Cities of Larkspur and Corte Madera that have one thing in common - you can look up most any time and view the awe-inspiring skyline of Mount Tamalpais.
