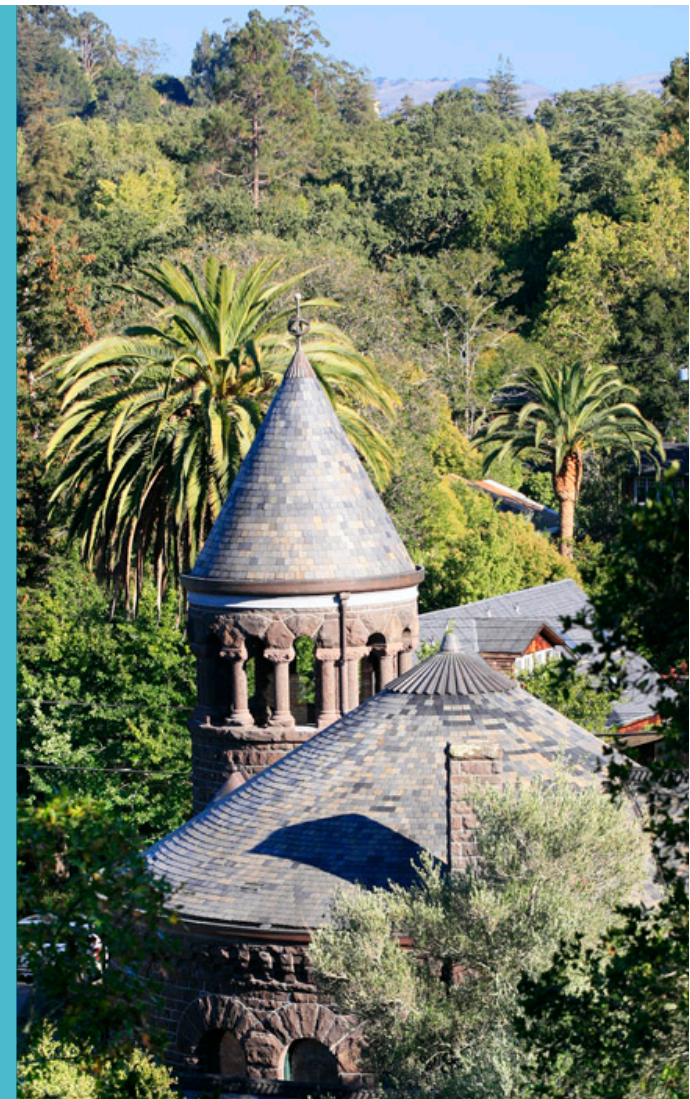

THINGS TO DO

Cataract Falls Hiking Trail
