October in Marin will be a great month for star gazing as the Sweetwater Music Hall and the Mill Valley Film Festival kick off a ten day festival of film screenings, music, parties, and visiting luminaries.

Music at the Sweetwater will once again partner with the Film Festival for a second year with eclectic performances by artists featured in MVFF39 films, as well as local

The opening of the current Sweetwater Music Hall in January of 2012 marked a rebirth of the landmark roots music venue and Bay Area treasure which originally opened on November 17, 1972. A local venture that is comprised of multiple investors including Bob Weir (Grateful Dead, Furthur) and other longtime supporters of the club, the Sweetwater Music Hall is a state-of-the-art nightclub and café that not only presents nationally recognized top-quality entertainment but also provides a comfortable home venue for local and emerging talent to perform and experiment.

Located in the Masonic Hall in Mill Valley, the Sweetwater Music Hall offers food, drinks, and a broad spectrum of live music and entertainment, including Open Mic Mondays with Marin County keys player Austin DeLone. The space is also available for private events. In addition to entertainment, the Sweetwater Music Hall includes a full-service restaurant and on-site catering led by renowned chef-restaurateur Gordon Drysdale (Pizza Antica, Café de Amis), who offers artfully crafted, fresh, locally sourced and organic fare. The Café serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner, and the full service espresso bar serves a variety of teas as well as premium coffee.
