# Half Day Tours of Marin

## Suggestion #1

**B**egin your morning at the Marin County Civic Center by walking around the Lagoon and feed the ducks and winter geese. Next, tour the Frank Lloyd Wright designed Civic Center, a national and state designated historic landmark. One hour walk-in docent-led tours are offered each Wednesday at 10:30a.m., leaving from the second floor Café, Room 233.

After your visit to Marin's county seat, drive the scenic North San Pedro Road Loop to China Camp State Park. To end the afternoon, visit downtown San Rafael along Fourth Street to have lunch at any one of the sidewalk cafés.

## Suggestion #2

**B**egin in San Rafael on Fifth Avenue to tour the Mission San Rafael Arcangel. Discover the past and present of San Rafael by strolling down Fifth and Mission Streets to view historic homes such as the Boyd Gate House, Marin History Museum, and the Falkirk Cultural Center.

Visit WildCare at 76 Albert Park Lane, a rescue mission for the rehabilitation of native species. One-way glass windows allow visitors to observe recovering animals and birds without disturbing them.

Buy fresh produce at San Rafael's Fourth Street Downtown Farmers Market on Thurs Evenings. This is a seasonal market operating from April to September.

## Suggestion #3

**V**isit the Bay Area Discovery Museum (family oriented) in Sausalito at the foot of the Golden Gate Bridge.

Afterwards, take a moderately adventurous hike up to the bridge through the Golden Gate National Recreation Area to view incredible vistas of the Bay, San Francisco city skyline and the Marin Headlands.
