San Rafael, CA – The Marin Convention & Visitors Bureau (MCVB) is pleased to announce the addition of an annual Art & Cultural Tour on Wednesday, May 20, 2015 from 8:15am to 4:30pm; transportation will be provided by Pure Luxury Transportation.

The day begins with a light breakfast welcome and historical tour of Frank Lloyd Wright's Marin and Civic Centers, hosted by Marin County Department of Cultural & Visitor Services, followed by a full day of art and cultural experiences at select venues including a tour of Falkirk Cultural Center, a tour and short movie at CFI's Smith Rafael Film Center, a tour of Art Works Downtown, and a tasting reception at Il Davide, all in downtown San Rafael. After lunch, attendees will also visit Marin Art & Garden Center in Ross to learn about its history and receive a tour of the grounds, which will include their amphitheater in the trees, basket garden, and other points of art & cultural history. In addition, docent tours of the Jose Moya del Pino Library in the Octagon House will be hosted by Ross Historical Society and a docent tour of the onsite art gallery will be hosted by Marin Society of Artists.
